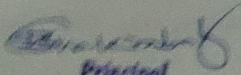

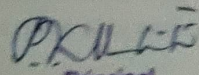

The Memorandum of understanding (MoU) is effective as on 30.05.2023 to establish an affiliation by and between

Maharaja Srischandra College, a NAAC accredited UG College and a renowned institute, affiliated to University of Calcutta, established in 1964. It is located at 20, Ramkanto Bose Street Kolkata 700003, West Bengal. This college is herein referred to as MSCC and represented by its Principal, **Dr. Shyamal Kumar Chakraborty**, referred to as FIRST PARTY, for the exchange of students, staff and faculty.

AND

Ananda Mohan College, a NAAC accredited UG College and a reputed institute affiliated to University of Calcutta, Kolkata, established in 1961. It is located at 102/1 Raja Rammohan Sarani, Kolkata-700009, West Bengal. This college is herein referred to AMC and represented by its Principal, **Dr. Pradip Kumar Maiti**, referred to as SECOND PARTY, for the exchange of students, staff and faculty.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually/collectively as college/colleges.

PREAMBLE

Whereas, MSCC and AMC have many areas of common interest in Science, Arts, and Commerce subjects, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy and research.

Now therefore, MSCC and AMC have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both the colleges agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity without any financial obligations.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Faculty/Staff exchanges

- i) Faculty exchange for the mutual benefit of both the institutions
- ii) Collaboration in teaching, research and development and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest
- iii) Exchange of academic materials and publications
- iv) Conducting lectures
- v) Undertaking joint research
- vi) Participating in seminars, workshops, symposia, other kinds of academic discussions,
- vii) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work

A Specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon. Terms and conditions for each visit will be worked out, keeping financial costs involved to the minimum.

B. Student Exchange

- a) Students in the exchange programme will be selected by mutual agreement between the home and the host college.
- b) Exchange students may be evaluated by the host institution if such an evaluative framework for the academic interest of students be worked out, this will in no way impede or influence her/his evaluation in home college or university assessment/evaluation.

C. Other areas

- a) To exchange information on research and educational programmes
- b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes
- c) To jointly organize seminars, faculty development programmes, workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- d) To explore the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff, faculty and students of both institutes.
- e) To use library reading room facilities for a specified period
- f) To use laboratory facilities in specific cases (with prior approval of Principal) for a limited period.

MSCC and AMC agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.
