## B.Sc. Summer Internship Programme 2026: Bridging Science and Digital Skills

The **Research Committee**, under the coordinatorship of **Dr. Raghwendra Mishra**, Department of Physiology, successfully organized the **Summer Internship Programme 2026** on "*Computer & Web Application in Science Education*" during May-June 2026. The programme was initially designed from a multidisciplinary perspective for 44 B.Sc. Semester-IV students of Ananda Mohan College, keeping in view the requirements of the CCF curriculum. Owing to its relevance and popularity, the initiative was subsequently extended to 55 Physiology Major students from *Vidyasagar College*, *Vidyasagar Metropolitan College*, *Surendranath College*





and *Bangabasi Evening College* through an **External Summer Internship Programme-2026**. The internship provided participants with hands-on exposure to emerging areas such as data analytics, artificial intelligence, cyber security, bio-cheminformatics, bioinformatics, Python programming, Internet of Things (IoT), nanoparticles, spectroscopy, biostatistics, data visualization, and Power BI, along with training in web-based academic resources and scientific data analysis. The programme combined lectures, practical assignments, and interactive sessions conducted by faculty members of the college, enabling students to develop essential digital and research-oriented competencies relevant to contemporary science education and interdisciplinary research. The programme featured lectures, demonstrations, assignments, and interactive sessions conducted by **Dr. Raghwendra Mishra** (Physiology), **Dr. Dhiman Mondal** (Library & Information Science), **Dr. Subhalakshmi Paul** (Economics), **Dr. Arijit Ghosh** (Physics), **Dr. Sounak Dutta** (Chemistry) and **Dr. Sanjay Dey** (Zoology), who shared their expertise across multidisciplinary areas of science and technology.

The enthusiastic participation of students and the active engagement of faculty members made the programme a resounding success. By integrating theoretical concepts with practical applications, the internship effectively contributed to skill enhancement, research preparedness and the objectives of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, fostering a culture of innovation and experiential learning among undergraduate students.

## Faculty Participation in the “Promise of Yoga 365” Movement

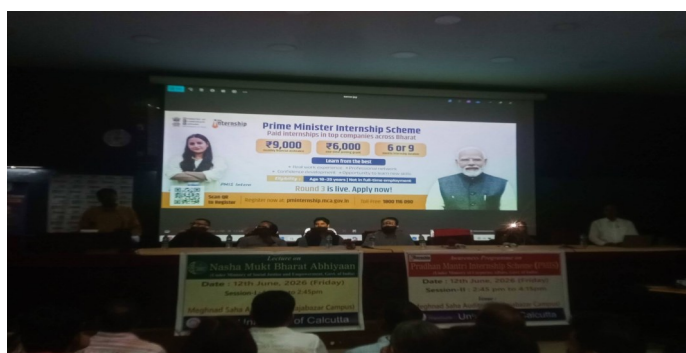

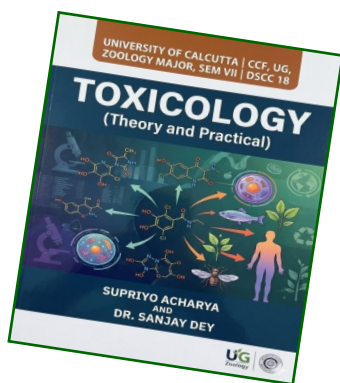
## Continuing Professional Development

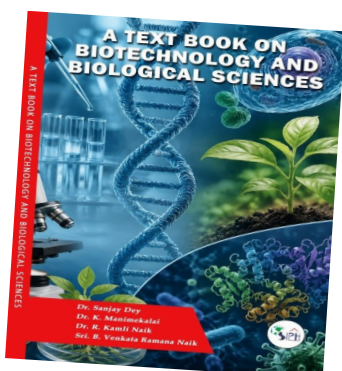

## Faculty Presentations & Academic Engagements

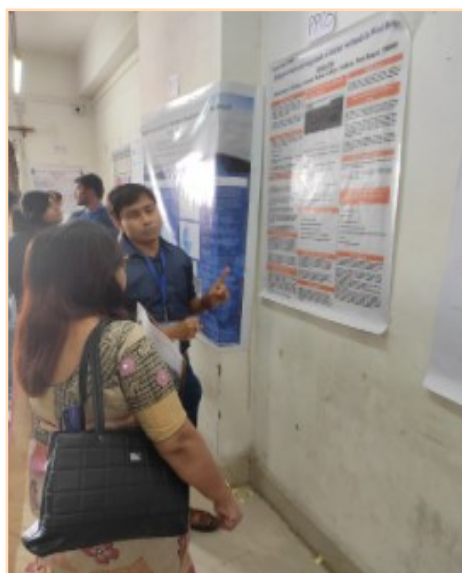
### Faculty Research Presentation on Wetland Ecology

**Dr. Sanjay Dey**, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Zoology, Ananda Mohan College, presented a poster at the seminar "*Current Trends in Biological Sciences – III*," organized by the Department of Biosciences, JIS University, in collaboration with the Microbiologist Society, India, on 7 April 2026 (Tuesday). His presentation, titled "*Ecological Status and Magnitude of Distinct Wetlands in West Bengal*," focused on assessing the faunal diversity across various wetland ecosystems. The study examined different biological groups, including avifauna, phytoplankton, zooplankton, aquatic insects, fishes, and mollusca, across multiple sampling sites.

The research highlighted the ecological significance of wetlands—often

referred to as "*Nature's Kidneys*"—for their role in water filtration and maintaining

environmental balance. It also drew attention to emerging environmental concerns such as heavy metal accumulation, sedimentation, and microplastic contamination, which pose serious threats to wetland ecosystems. The presentation underscores the department's ongoing research initiatives in environmental conservation and ecological studies.



## Paper Presentation in National Seminar (Online)

**Dr. Rina Singh**, Assistant Professor, Department of Hindi presented a research paper titled “*Stri Atmakatha: Vyaktigat Sangharsh ka Aina*” at a National Seminar (online) organized by Punjab National Bank, Krishnanagar, in collaboration with the IQAC and Department of Hindi, City College, Kolkata on 25 March 2026 (Wednesday).

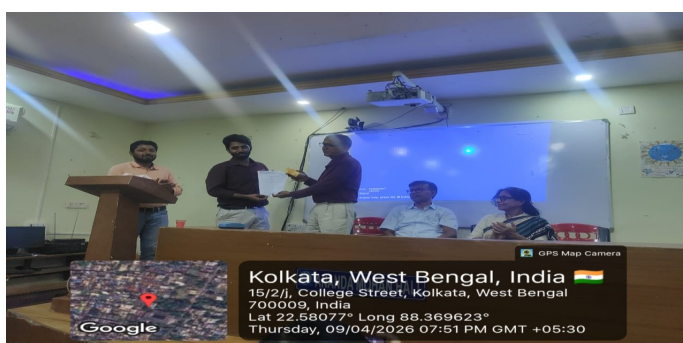
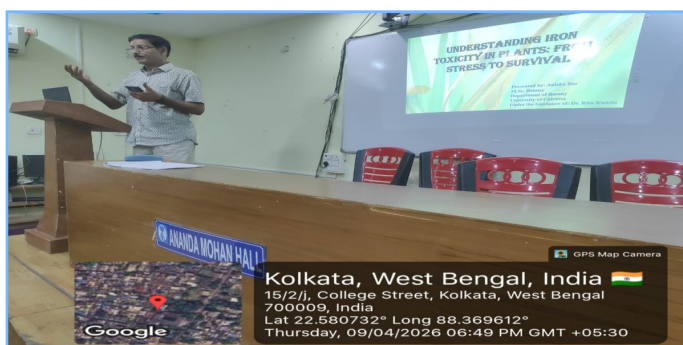
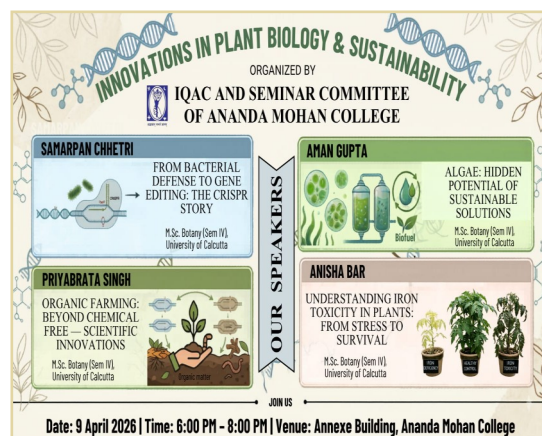
### Seminar on Innovations in Plant Biology and Sustainability

Semester - IV students of the Department of Botany, University of Calcutta. **Ms. Anisha Bar** delivered a presentation on “*Understanding Iron Toxicity in Plants: From Stress to Survival*” highlighting plant adaptation

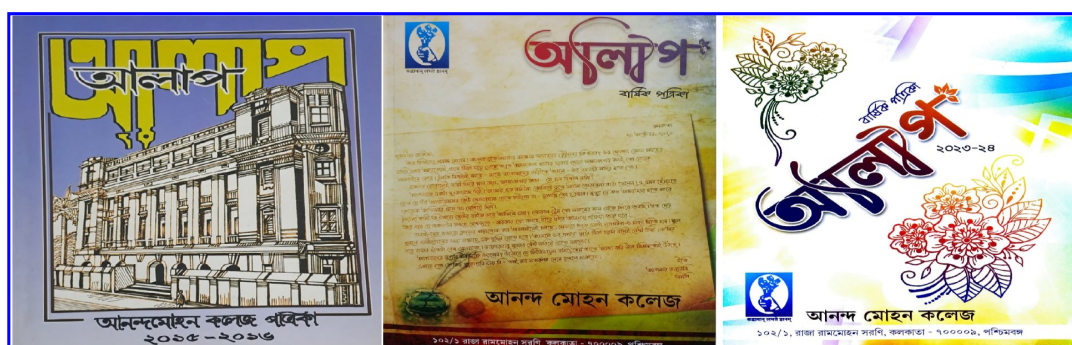

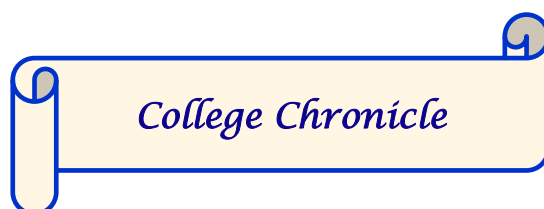
## Echoes from the Library Stacks

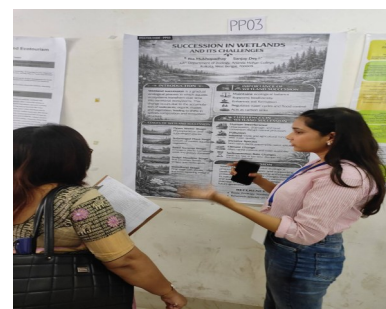

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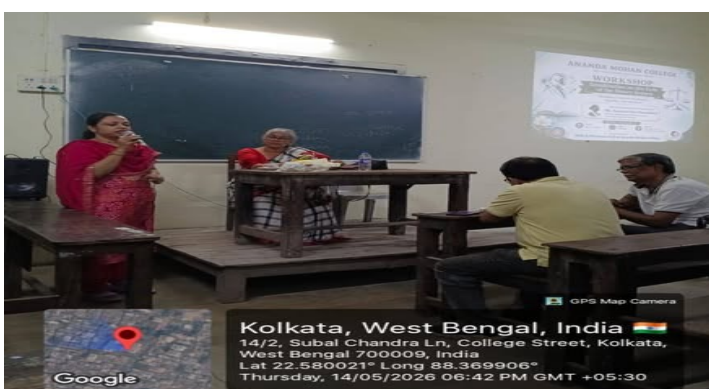
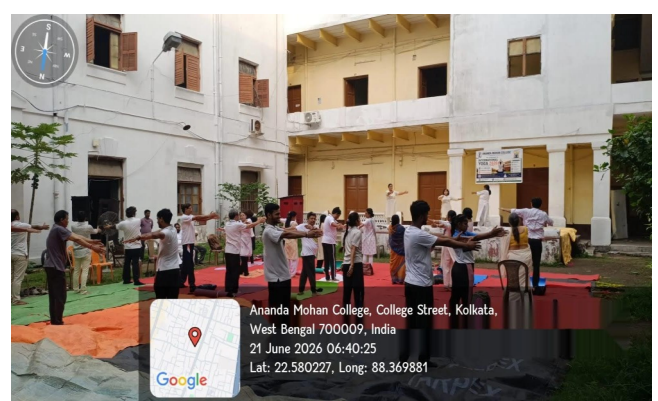
## Commerce Students Shine in NISM–SEBI National Financial Literacy Quiz 2026
